## Solution to A COLLECTIVE OF PUZZLES:

Each set of words is a single puzzle involving only those words, each with a different mechanism.

1. Add a letter to the beginning of the word to create a new word
2. Fill one letter into the space between words to create a consecutive sequence of three letters in the alphabet
3. Take the double letter in the word
4. The first syllable of each word sounds like a letter
5. In each position 1-5, one letter appears twice in the set of words.

Each answer is a collective noun used for a certain type of animal.

| Number | Answer | Animal |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| 1 | MUTATION | THRUSH |
| 2 | YOKE | OXEN |
| 3 | GAM | WHALES |
| 4 | MEMORY | ELEPHANTS |
| 5 | CRASH | RHINOS |

Taking the first letter of the type of animal spells another collective noun, TOWER. This is a group of GIRAFFES. Congratulations to CoyoteCreed, Golem, and Moor Xu who were the first three to submit the correct answer to last week's puzzle on our website.
