Each of these answers is a long word or phrase containing a lot of Is and Os . The title clues that $\mathrm{I}=1$. Extract the Is and Os from each word (there are always 5 in total) and read the resulting string as a number written in binary. Then, convert that number to a letter (as $A=1, B=2$ ). Reading top to bottom, the answer is BINARY.
