Solution to **The Small Screen**:

This puzzle is a variation on the standard word search. The title of the puzzle hints that the puzzle is related to videos, in this case movies. The flavor text indicates that for this word search not all the words lie along a straight line.

At first you may notice many words, and then hopefully will notice that they form famous quotes from movies. Once you have correctly identified all of the movie quotes, you will be left with unused letters and a conspicuously empty cell. When read from left to right, top to bottom yield the clue phrase: WE DIDNT NEED [] WE HAD FACES.

This is a quote from the movie Sunset Blvd. and the missing word is "DIALOGUE" which is the answer to the puzzle. The flavor text is also a reference to another famous quote from the same movie.
